Many thanks to Betty Rackley and her years of service at Paul's.

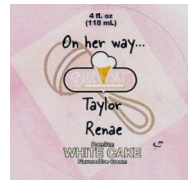


## COOL BY ASSOCIATION: The First Blue Sky Baby
